



There's a lot of laughable logic (which is nothing new for the genre, to be fair), mislabeled items in the hidden object scenes (which is annoying AF), weird word usage ("caster" instead of "wheel" - though I guess it's nice for expanding your vocabulary) and the same song plays from beginning to end. The art is nice enough at least, the puzzles were fine, and the story was okay. It didn't smack you over the head with explanations, but I actually kind of missed the usual narmy *find clue* "Gasp! This must be why the villain is such and such!".

Anyway, if you play a ton of HoGs just kind of on principle, this is perfectly acceptable, but there's a lot better out there. I wish there was a "take it or leave it" option, but I guess I'll go with not recommended since I'm not exactly raring to get people to play it. PLUS:- MARK HAMMILL AND KEVIN CONROY voicing Joker and Batman !!!!!. Amphora is one of those tiny little masterpieces that you know are out there, but you only get to hear about it by accident. And my, what a happy accident this is!

A game of love, sorrow and perseverance, Amphora is a stunning art piece by a two-man studio called Moondrop. From the very first scene, I found myself completely immersed within its stained glass visuals and hauntingly beautiful music. There is no text, speech or even a tutorial. You learn about the game, its story and its mechanics by simply exploring the lovely scene in front of you. That might sound a bit troubling, but in practice it works wonderfully.

Even though some of the puzzles are quite easy, I recommend taking it slow. Try to look beyond the puzzle and explore the scenery, otherwise you'll easily miss out on the story.

Overall, Amphora has been one of my favourite gaming experiences in 2015 so far. I have a feeling Moondrop is another Supergiant in the making. Time will tell.... It's no third season of Wakfu, but this broght a big ol' \u2665\u

Why is the Unity engine required to emulate a game from 1982? The system requirements are insane. It's better to get Pac-Man Museum and the DLC.. Overpriced, unbalanced, inflexible. This is a game that is over 4 years old now, and still costs 20 dollars. It's ridiculous! Second, many of the in-game options are unbalanced. I have been assassinated, by environmentalists, when I had a carbon tax and strong anti-pollution regulations. Most importantly, I find, the amount of actual changes you can make besides different degrees of neoliberal capitalism is very low. You can't have any kind of socialism(Social democracy is very attainable, but the closest thing to a leftist ideology in the game, and it's still capitalist.), you can't abolish the government, and limited government doesn't work great either. You can't really have fascism either.

Even the sequel to this game(Democracy 3) is still plagued by many of these problems, but slightly less so. If you really want a game like this, just skip this one and get Democracy 3, but the entire series isn't the best, I find. There isn't a really high amount of replayability, either, it all gets to be the same pattern, for me. (Make some changes, keep budget balanced, some terrorist group gets angry, I get assassinated after about an hour of playing)

Can't recommend.. This game is amazing in every single way. The art is beautiful, the characters are likeable, and the story is compelling.. This is a disgusting rip off of a game. DO NOT BUY IT. IT IS A CASH GRAB. After 5,500+ hours in ark, I can say for sure that this is just a complete \vec{v}vving rip off. The megapithecus and therizinos look like n64 characters.. Unlike the original, this DLC and the Saxons DLC offer you a sandbox experience, not to mention the pleasure of exploring your Stronghold and its features right from your first winter. Compared to the original campaign, the 2 DLC campaigns offers new features and balances. In particular, the Diplomacy button is unique to the 2 DLCs, and replaces the rather arbitrary way AI kingdoms declare war on you in the original campaign.

The Welsh start at the northwest and like the Saxons, can conquer a second Stronghold for themselves very quickly (faster than the Saxons).

If you want to enjoy the experience this game offers at your own pace, get the 2 DLCs.
